

Arctic Photography Adventure 2012

Peterson's Point Lake Lodge Northwest Territories

This seven-day program gives you the opportunity to capture the Northern Lights, (Aurora Borealis), the tundra in autumn, migratory wildlife and birds, including barren-ground caribou, grizzly bears, and wolves. The aurora is approaching Solar max in 2013 and the next few years will offer the best aurora light shows of the decade. The workshop includes 2 days in Yellowknife and 5 days at Peterson's Point Lake lodge 250 Km north of Yellowknife. Suitable for all level of photographers or anyone interested in exploring the tundra and viewing nature.

Your photo guide will be Dr. Robert Berdan. Robert is a professional nature photographer and biologist with numerous photos published in books and magazines (e.g. Outdoor Photography Canada, Photo Life, Canadian Geographic).
